THE RECTOR

- HAVING REGARD TO** Rectoral Decree no. 553 of 20.07.2026, by which the call for applications for admission to the First-level University Master Programme in "Entrepreneurship and Innovation Management" (Master EIM) - 6th Edition - A.Y. 2026/2027 was issued;
- ACKNOWLEDGING** that the aforementioned call provides, among the selection methods, for a written test and specifies the corresponding scores assigned to the written test and the interview;
- CONSIDERING** the request for correction submitted by the Director of the Master Programme, stating that the provision for a written test and the corresponding scores assigned to the written test and the interview resulted from a clerical error, and requesting its removal and the consequent adjustment of the score assigned to the interview;
- DEEMING** in light of the above, to amend Rectoral Decree no. 553 of 20.07.2026 as requested;
- HAVING REGARD TO** the University Statute currently in force;

HEREBY DECREES

Art. 1) The call for applications referred to in Rectoral Decree no. 553 of 20.07.2026 is hereby amended as follows:

Article 1 **General provisions**

Where it reads:

The University of Naples "Parthenope" announces, for the 2026-2027 academic year, a public selection procedure based on qualifications, an interview and a written test for admission to the First-level University Master Programme in "Entrepreneurship and Innovation Management" - 6th Edition.

It shall read:

The University of Naples "Parthenope" announces, for the 2026-2027 academic year, a public selection procedure based on qualifications and an interview for admission to the First-level University Master Programme in "Entrepreneurship and Innovation Management" - 6th Edition.

Article 4 **Admission requirements**

Where it reads:

The Master Programme is open to a maximum of 25 participants (minimum number: 15) holding a first-cycle degree or an equivalent qualification. Candidates who have not yet graduated may participate in the selection procedure subject to obtaining the qualification by the deadline set for enrolment. Admission to the Master Programme is subject to evaluation of the curriculum vitae, participation in a selection interview and completion of a written test.

It shall read:

The Master Programme is open to a maximum of 25 participants (minimum number: 15) holding a first-cycle degree or an equivalent qualification. Candidates who have not yet graduated may participate in the selection procedure subject to obtaining the qualification by the deadline set for enrolment. Admission to the Master Programme is subject to evaluation of the curriculum vitae and participation in a selection interview.



Article 8 **Admission procedure**

Where it reads:

The Master Programme is intended for a minimum of 15 and a maximum of 25 participants. Candidates shall be selected on the basis of an evaluation of their curricula vitae, an interview and a written test. Applicants shall be assessed by an Examining Board appointed by Rectoral Decree on the proposal of the Technical and Operational Committee. The Board shall also assess candidates' language proficiency, which is an essential requirement for attending the Master Programme taught in English.

The Board may award a maximum of 100 points, allocated as follows:

1) evaluation of the curriculum vitae and qualifications (maximum 50 points):

- final degree grade: up to 20 points
- qualifications: up to 10 points
- curriculum vitae: up to 20 points

2) written test: maximum 25 points

3) interview: maximum 25 points

In the event of a tie, preference shall be given to the younger candidate.

The selection results shall be published on the University of Naples "Parthenope" website and on the Master Programme website within 3 days of the date of the final selection assessment.

All communications concerning the selection procedure and the merit ranking lists shall be published on the University of Naples "Parthenope" website. No individual communications shall be sent to candidates, except in cases of exclusion.

On the scheduled dates, all candidates who have not received notice of exclusion from the selection procedure must report to the examination venue by the specified time, carrying a valid identity document. Failure to attend the interview or the written test shall result in the candidate's automatic exclusion. The interview or written test may not be taken on dates other than those scheduled, even where the candidate is unable to attend due to force majeure or other duly documented impediments.

No reimbursement of expenses shall be due to candidates taking the assessments.

For the purposes of the final merit ranking, the Board shall take into account the evaluation of the curriculum vitae, qualifications, publications, written test and interview.

It shall read:

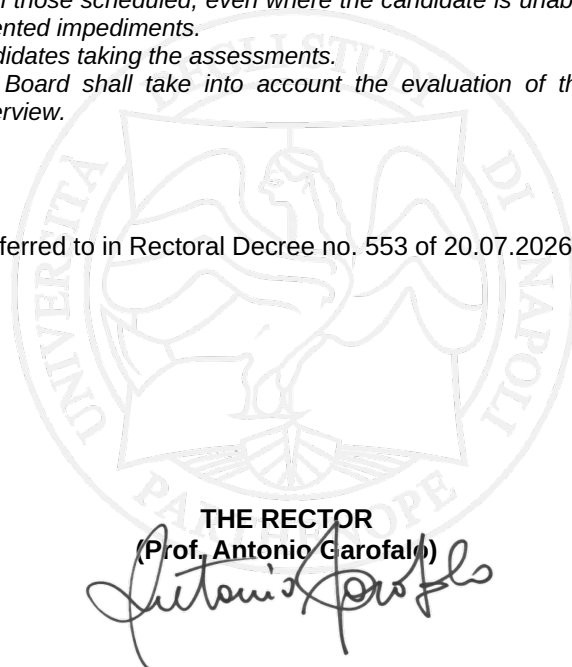
The interview may not be taken on dates other than those scheduled, even where the candidate is unable to attend due to force majeure or other duly documented impediments.

Art. 2) All other provisions contained in the call for applications referred to in Rectoral Decree no. 553 of 20.07.2026 shall remain unchanged.
